2009-10 CAL LUTHERAN SEASON PREVIEW

Over the last three seasons the Cal Lutheran men's basketball team has posted a 56-21 overall record with a SCIAC Co-Championship and a pair of second place conference finishes. In 2009-2010 the Kingsmen return their starting five from a year ago and have been garnered with a No. 14 preseason national ranking.

Seniors Andy Meier and Kyle Knudsen have been a key part to the recent success of the program with 131 starts and 1,762 points combined over the last three seasons.

Head coach Rich Rider is in his 16th season leading a Kingsmen basketball program that has claimed five SCIAC Championships since their inception in 1991.

"We are going to have to continue to develop our depth this year to be successful," Rider said.

On Dec. 29-30 the Kingsmen will host the Thrivent Financial Tournament featuring CLU and three out-of-state teams; Monmouth (IL) College, Hamline (MN) University and Wheaton (IL) College. Wheaton finished last year as the No. 2 team in the D3Hoops Top-25 and are ranked 15th in this year's preseason poll.

"The non-conference schedule is designed to prepare us for a very tough and challenging SCIAC schedule," Rider said. "We have some outstanding teams coming to Gilbert Arena this year."

Conference play will begin on Jan. 9 when the Kingsmen host Caltech. CLU will enjoy the holiday season at home with an eight game home stand from Dec. 12 to Jan. 9.

2009-10 HAMLIN SEASON PREVIEW

Nelson Whitmore looks for his first MIAC playoff berth in his third season at the helm with a young, talented, and committed 2009-10 Piper squad.

Whitmore returns five players from the 2008-09 campaign that finished 9-16 overall and 8-12 in MIAC play. They Pipers made a late run at the playoffs last season, posting victories in six of their last nine conference games.

One player not back from that team is 2009 Jostens Trophy finalist Tony Thrasher. Thrasher graduated seventh all-time in scoring at Hamline with 1,360 career points and is ninth all-time in rebounds with 452. However, Whitmore returns five strong players from that run and brings in an impressive list of new names.

Whitmore's team is young, but they are a talented and committed group. The players are a hard-working corps that can only be classified as "gym rats" for their passion and dedication to improving over the off-season. The Pipers will be a tougher, more athletic team on the court in 2009-10 as they look to jump into the MIAC top six and play into March this year.

2009-10 MONMOUTH SEASON PREVIEW

Entering his third year at the helm, Monmouth College coach Mark Vershaw is hoping to blend a mix of youth and experience into a successful season.

"The key will be for our newcomers to jell quickly with our veterans," said Vershaw. "We'll have to depend on some first-year players to make significant contributions."

Not that the Fighting Scots don't return some talent. Four starters are back from a year ago, including Eric Cogdill (East Moline, Ill./United Township) and Zach Ott (East Peoria, Ill./East Peoria), who were two of the Scots' top three scorers and rebounders last season. Assist leader Eric Grant (Roseville, Ill./Monmouth-Roseville) and tough defender Corey Gruber (Galesburg, Ill./Abingdon) at guards round out the returning starters. Guard Tyler Morrow (East Peoria, Ill./East Peoria) will return for his final campaign after a year-long study abroad stint and will join Ott as the only seniors on the squad.

No less than eight other newcomers form a "very athletic" group that gives the Scots a variety of scoring options. That mix includes "good-sized" guards Michael De Decker (Carbondale, Ill./Murphysboro) and Kevin Fay (Hennepin, Ill./Putnam County) – son of former multisport MC athlete Harold Fay. At 6-foot-3, the younger Fay offers another outside threat that will be hard to stop. De Decker possesses the ability to penetrate, giving Vershaw another offensive option.

2009-10 WHEATON SEASON PREVIEW

The Wheaton College men's basketball program begins the 'Mike Schauer Era' with the 2009-10 campaign for the Thunder. Schauer, who graduated from Wheaton in 1993, replaces Bill Harris – his former head coach, who retired this spring after 18 seasons at the helm of the program. Schauer, who served as Harris' assistant from 1993-2000, returns to his alma mater after seven seasons as the head coach at Gordon College, where his teams won nearly 70 percent of their games in that time.

The arrival of Schauer and departure of Harris is not the only change Wheaton will undergo this season. Guard Kent Raymond, Wheaton's second-leading scorer in school history, has graduated, as has All-Region center Andy Wiele. With much of the focus on Raymond and Wiele last season, Wheaton posted a 26-4 record with a CCIW Championship.

When asked what people who have watched the Thunder under Harris will see in his team this season Schauer responds, "I think people will see that the focus on defensive intensity hasn't changed. That will be the same, because quite literally the defensive scheme is almost identical." He continues, "I think that one thing some people may see as different is that there is probably a little more offensive freedom for some kids that didn't have it the last couple of years. That's not necessarily a philosophical change as much as it is the reality of the situation. Guys like Jake Carwell, Tim McCrary and even Ben Panner didn't have to do as much offensively because most of what has been done the past few years has gone through Kent and Andy. Now guys like Jake and Tim will have to do a little more for us to succeed."

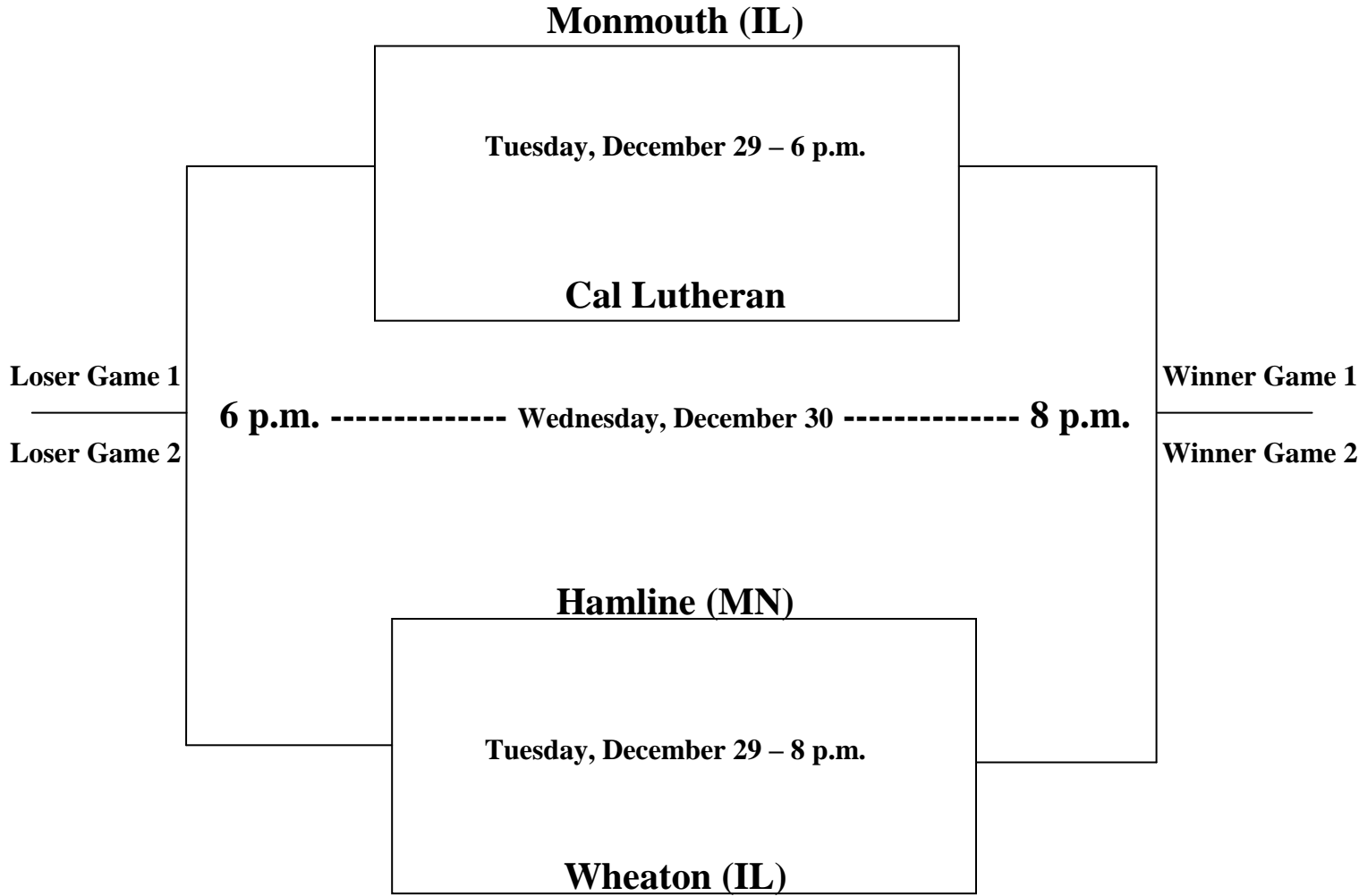
